Innovate **health research** to define the biological mechanisms and pathways between climate hazards and health outcomes to design effective technology and social and behavior change interventions.



Design rigorous youth co-led climate research to develop inclusive life skills and education curricula for **adolescents, especially girls, to thrive** in the emerging green economies and societies reshaped by climate change.




Deliver datasets, insights, and predictive models that identify climate risk hotspots and ensure equitable delivery of climate adaptation policy to the most **vulnerable**, with a focus on urban settings.
